Banana-Oat-Chocolate Chip Cookies

3 very ripe Bananas

2 Cups Old-Fashioned Oats (not instant and not
steel-cut)

1 Cup pitted and chopped dried Medjool Dates

1/4 Cup Canola or Vegetable Oil

1/2 teaspoon Ground Cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon Salt

1/2 Cup Chocolate Chips

Preheat the oven to 350.

Mash the bananas in a bowl. Add the remaining
ingredients and mix well.

Allow the mixture to sit for 10 minutes.



Using a mini ice cream scoop or Tablespoon, scoop out
the dough onto a Silpat or Parchment-lined baking
sheet. (To make bars instead of cookies, place the
dough in a 7x11-inch dish sprayed with cooking spray,
bake for 35 to 40 minutes, until golden, and allow to
cool. Cut into bars or squares.)

Bake for 25 minutes, or until golden.

Cool and Serve.
