<u>Saint Patrick's Day dye free spinach cake</u> (check out this link for more dye free green recipes! http://weelicious.com/2013/03/14/23-dye-free-st-patricks-day-recipes/)

Ingredients

1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce

1 large egg

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 cup fresh spinach, packed

1/3 cup sugar

2 tablespoons vegetable or canola oil

1 1/2 cups all purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

Preparation

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 F.
- 2. Place the first 6 ingredients in a food processor and puree.
- 3. Place the remaining ingredients in a separate bowl and combine.
- 4. Pour the spinach puree in a large mixing bowl.
- 5. Slowly mix the dry ingredients into the wet until combined.
- 6. Scoop batter into a greased mini muffin tin, filling each cup 2/3 of the way.
- 7. Bake for 12 minutes.
- 8. Serve.
