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Gerry's Kitchen Squash Cookies

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 Cups Butter, Softened
- 2 1/4 Cups White Sugar
- 2 1/4 Cups packed Brown Sugar
- 6 Eggs
- 4 1/2 Cups mashed, cooked Butternut Squash
- 7 1/2 Cups All-Purpose Flour
- 1 TBSP. Baking Soda
- 2 TBSP. Ground Cinnamon
- 1 1/2 tsp. Salt
- 1 1/2 tsp. Ground Nutmeg
- 3/4 tsp. Ground Ginger
- 3/4 tsp. Ground Allspice
- 2 TBSP. and 1 1/2 tsp. Baking Powder



Directions:

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.
2. In a large mixing bowl, cream butter and sugars until fluffy. Beat in the eggs and squash. Sift together the flour, baking soda, baking powder, and spices; add to mixture, stirring until well blended. Spoon onto cookie sheets spacing cookies 2 inches apart.
3. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes in the preheated oven, until edges are golden.
