Hawaiian Ham & Swiss Slider

Ingredients:

- About 2 Pounds Sliced Thin Deli Honey Ham
- 1 pound sliced Swiss Cheese
- 1/3 Cup Mayonnaise
- 1 TBSP. Poppy Seeds
- 1 1/2 TBSP Dijon Mustard
- 1/2 Cup Butter Melted
- 1 TBSP Onion Powder
- 1/2 tsp. Worcestershire Sauce
- 2 Packages (12 Count) King's Hawaiian Original Hawaiian Sweet Dinner Rolls



Directions:

1. Cut rolls in half and spread mayo onto 1 side of the rolls.
2. Place a slice or two of ham and slice of Swiss Cheese in roll.
3. Replace the top of the rolls and bunch them closely together into a baking dish.
4. In a medium bowl, whisk together poppy seeds, Dijon mustard, melted butter, onion powder and Worcestershire sauce.
5. Pour sauce over the rolls, just covering the tops.
6. Cover with foil and let sit for 10 minutes. (Or refrigerate until ready to bake)
7. Bake at 400 degrees Fahrenheit covered for 15 minutes. Bake uncovered an additional 15 minutes, watching the last five until tops are golden brown.


We have had a busy week!
